Qirāţs (Mountains) of Good Deeds

When we are in Al-Ḥaramayn (the two Holy Masjids in Al-Madinah & Makkah), most often there are dozens of Ṣalātul-Janāzah (Funeral prayers) that are performed for the deceased, so do not deprive yourself of this great opportunity, for you will be rewarded, by Allāh, with an abundance of goodness, and mountains of good deeds.

Şalātul-Janāzah (Funeral prayers) in Al-Ḥaramayn

(the two Holy Masjids in Al-Madinah & Makkah)

1) The Most Preferred Opinion:

If there are multiple deceased people to be prayed for after a Şalāh, the rewards are multiplied; because the Ḥadīth connects the reward with the Janāzah (funeral), as it points out that: (Whoever witnesses a Janāzah until Ṣalah is performed over it, he will have one Qirāt [mountain's worth]).

2) The Most Preferred Opinion:

The multiplication of rewards for the performance of an obligatory Şalah in Al-Ḥaramayn includes the performance of Ṣalātul-Janāzah; due to the general nature of the Ḥadīths and their comprehensiveness.

It is concluded from the two previous points:

That whoever performs Ṣalātul-Janāzah in the Makkan Ḥaram (Holy Masjid in Makkah) is rewarded with one hundred thousand mountains' worth of rewards, multiplied by the number of deceased that are prayed for.

This is a great reward, and all praise is due to Allāh for His favor and generosity.
